I hope to do that through this year, whatever my story looks like... will you join me?

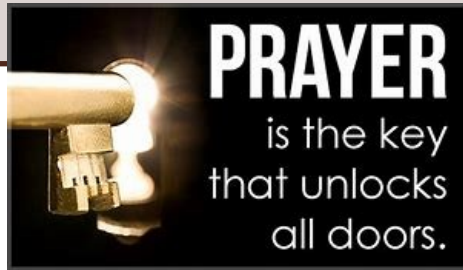
